Considering Jesus' response, what good can come out of suffering?

Look at verses 27-38. In what other way was this man's blindness  
removed?

What was the response of the following to Jesus' miracle?

- Blind man
- Neighbors
- Pharisees
- Parents

In what ways were these people more blind than the blind man?

(Cynicism, traditionalism, fear, other?)

What was the result of the healed man's testimony? 9:34

What impact would it have to be excommunicated from the synagogue? Verse 34

What character do you identify with most and why?

What did Jesus mean in verse 39? How does this tie in with verse 3?

What do you think of the Pharisees' question in verse 40?

Compare this idea of spiritual blindness with 2 Corinthians 4:4. What is the source of spiritual blindness?

What is the way for blindness to be removed? 2 Corinthians 4:5-6

Who do you know that is spiritually blind? What can you do to help him/her see? What can you do as a LifeGroup to work together to help him/her see?

Is it possible that by not thinking about, seeing, or praying for the lost that we have a spiritual blindness? Why does Jesus tell us to "open" our eyes?" John 4: 35

What difference will this life lesson make in your life?
